This is a document written with a typewriter on a piece of paper.

Typewritten Documents Have Structure

Documents typed onto a physical piece of paper contain structured text that uses structural elements such as:

- Sentences
- Paragraphs
- A document title
- Sections with headings
- Unordered lists like this one
- Ordered lists
- Tables

The technical publishing industry sometimes uses the term structured text to mean specifically documents written in an XML language. However, even a document typed with a typewriter onto a physical piece of paper has structured text.

Typewritten Documents Can Have Tables

Documents typed with a typewriter can even have text structured using tables, as in the following example.

Not good for...	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Frequent editing of text- Sharing documents across distances	<ul style="list-style-type: none">- Writing where there is no electricity
